LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

~~The Collective Agreement currently provides that bargaining unit members cannot be required to teach Off-Campus or Summer Session courses, but may do so on a voluntary basis. The purpose of this letter is to clarify certain limited circumstances where Off-Campus and/or Summer Session teaching may be required. This is an acceptable requirement where a limited term appointment has resulted from a consolidation of stipendiary positions which had clearly been posted as related to either Off-Campus or Summer Session courses. Similarly, a limited term appointee may be required to undertake such courses where the limited term advertisement clearly specified the Off-Campus and/or Summer requirements. In the latter case, where the limited term appointment is for two (2) years or more (either at the outset, or on a cumulative basis for an individual who has had previous limited term appointments), the Association's prior consent is required. TUFAs shall respond to any such request for consent within five (5) days of receipt, and such consent may not be unreasonably withheld. Failure to respond shall be regarded as consent.~~
